

AGREEMENT FOR CONNECTION
TO SEWER SYSTEM

The Town of Westport, Indiana agrees that the Southeast Baptist Youth Camp shall be permitted to connect the Youth Camp's facilities to the sewer system of the Town, provided that the following conditions are met:

1. All components of the system to be connected to Westport's sewer system shall be constructed according to the specifications reviewed and approved by Commonwealth Engineers on behalf of the Town. Copies of all construction permits required from the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and state and local Board of Health shall be provided to the Town prior to construction.

2. The primary vent point for the system shall be located at least five hundred (500) feet outside the corporate limits of the Town. If odors from the connection point between the systems exceed a reasonable level as determined by Westport sewer system personnel, the cost of correcting odor problems shall be paid by the Youth Camp, and the method used for that correction shall be subject to approval by the Westport Sewer Utility.

3. The Youth Camp shall be responsible for repair or replacement of any components of the Town's receiving manhole and to the next manhole downstream from the connection point which are damaged by corrosion. The Youth Camp shall be permitted, at its cost, to coat the inside of these two manholes to minimize corrosion on the manhole steps, frame, cover, and any exposed openings in the concrete.

4. The Youth Camp at its expense shall install a meter which shall be read monthly by the Westport sewer utility for billing purposes. The meter shall remain the property of the Youth Camp, which shall pay any expenses for regular operation and maintenance of the meter.

5. The Youth Camp shall comply with all provisions of the sewer rate and use ordinances of Westport, including any amendments made after the execution of this Agreement.
