

ORDINANCE NO. 1977-2

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SALE  
OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED  
IN AND PRESENTLY OWNED BY THE TOWN OF WESTPORT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Westport, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That it is in the best interests of the Town of Westport to dispose of certain real property located in and presently owned by the Town of Westport, to-wit:

(a) Parcel No. 1.

The East Half of Lot Number Seven (7) in the Original Plat of the Town of Westport.

(b) Parcel No. 2.

A part of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 8 North, Range 9 East, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:


Beginning at a point where the south line of Lot Number 120 in Sharp and Back's Addition to the town of Westport, if extended west, would intersect the West line of said Section 6, Township and Range aforesaid; thence East along the South line of Lots Numbers 120, 118 and 117 to a point 33 feet distant, at right angles, from the center of the railroad track formerly owned by the Chicago, Terre Haute and Southeastern Railway Company; thence in a southerly direction parallel to and 33 feet distant from the center of said railroad track to the west line of the Northwest quarter of said Section 6; thence North 210 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre, more or less.


Also, the former 66 foot wide right-of-way of the C.M. ST. P.&P. Railroad Co., extending across the southwesterly part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 8 North, Range 9 East, extending between Range and West Streets in the town of Westport, Indiana.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 9th day of April, 1977.
