

ORDINANCE 80-4

CURFEW HOURS FOR CHILDREN 17 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER, TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA

WHEREAS, West's Annotated Indiana Code 31-6-4-2 provides that towns may, by ordinance, advance any curfew time within their jurisdictions by 1 hour from that established by the above state law; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Westport determines that the curfew times established by the above state law are later than is reasonable at the moment for public safety within its jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTFORT, INDIANA THAT:

- Sec. 1. It is a curfew violation for a child thirteen (13), fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), or seventeen (17) years of age to be in a public place:
 - (a) between midnight and 5 a.m. on Saturday or Sunday;
 - (b) after 10 p.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday; or
 - (c) before 5 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday.
- Sec. 2. It is a curfew violation for a child under thirteen (13) years of age to be in a public place after 9 p.m. or before 5 a.m. on any day.
 - Sec 3. Sections 1 and 2 do not apply to a child who is:
 - (a) accompanied by his parent, guardian, or custodian;
- (b) accompanied by an adult specified by his parent, guardian, or cust-odian; or
- (c) participating in or returning from lawful employment or a lawful athletic, educational, entertainment, religious, or social event.

Adopted this 13th day of October, 1980 by the Board of Trustees in public session at the Town Hall Building, Westport, Indiana.
