ORDINANCE NO. 1982 - 82-2

AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING DOGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the health, safety and well-being of the town residents requires dogs be controlled within the town limits of the Town of Westport, Indiana.

IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA, that:

1. All dogs be restricted upon the property of their owners rather than being permitted to run at will within the town limits of the Town of Westport, Indiana.
 2. Dogs not so restricted, as provided above, shall be restrained on a leash when on property dedicated to public use (whether that be streets, sidewalks, public parks) within the town limits of the Town of Westport, Indiana.
 3. Dogs found to be running at will on property dedicated to public use (whether that be streets, sidewalks, public parks) shall be shot on sight by law enforcement officers employed by the Town of Westport, Indiana.
- This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.

Adopted this 19th day of April, 1982, by the Board of Trustees, Town of Westport, Indiana, during its April, 1982 public meeting, Town Hall Building, Westport, Indiana.




