ORDINANCE NO. 1982 - 4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES  
FOR DAMAGING WESTPORT WATER COMPANY METERS

WHEREAS, Certain Westport Water Company meters have been damaged through being turned on or off by individuals other than employees of the Westport Water Company;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA:

That customers of the Westport Water Company, whose water meters have been damaged through being turned on or off by individuals other than employees of the Westport Water Company, shall reimburse the Westport Water Company for expenses incurred in repairing or replacing such damaged water meters.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after adoption by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Westport, Indiana, and publication in a newspaper of general circulation within Decatur County, Indiana.

Adopted this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1982, by the Board of Trustees, Town of Westport, Indiana, during its May, 1982 public meeting at the Town Hall Building, Westport, Indiana.
