

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A UNIFORM
SEWER CHARGE FOR TOWN WATER
COMPANY SERVICE NONUSERS

WHEREAS, municipal sewer charges are not regulated by the Public Service Commission of Indiana in that a municipal utility is defined to include only municipally owned gas, water and electric companies;

WHEREAS, sewer rates have been set based upon water consumption; and

WHEREAS, certain real estate within the Town limits continue to receive municipal sewer service but no longer receive municipal water service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. SEWER SERVICE USERS. All real estate within the Town limits upon which are located improvements containing facilities for sanitary waste disposal shall dispose of such sanitary waste through the Town's sewer system rather than by septic systems or other means.

SECTION 2. SEWER CHARGES FOR NON-USERS OF TOWN WATER COMPANY SERVICES. The owners of real estate within the Town limits upon which are located improvements containing facilities for sanitary waste disposal but which do not receive Town water company service shall pay a flat monthly charge of \$ 10.00 for sewer service in the month of January, 1983 and each succeeding month thereafter pursuant to Indiana Code 36-9-2-16.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and signature by the president of the board of trustees attested to by the clerk-treasurer.
