

ORDINANCE 83- 2

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING GAME
MACHINES PLAYED BY THE PUBLIC
FOR A FEE CHARGED

WHEREAS, There are a certain number of game machines located within the Town played by the public for a fee charged; and

WHEREAS, The Town believes it is in the best interests of the public that such game machines be licensed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT:

SECTION 1. MACHINES LICENSED. That all game machines, video or otherwise, within the Town limits played by the public for a fee charged be licensed by the Clerk-Treasurer, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-5-6-6 (6), in the month of January each year upon payment by the owner thereof of an annual license fee of \$20.⁰⁰ per game machine;

SECTION 2. LICENSE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION. That the town executive may suspend or revoke, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-5-4-11, any issued license for a violation of the terms or conditions of the license or of the law under which it was issued;

SECTION 3. PENALTY. For every day after the 31st day of January each year that such game machines remain unlicensed a penalty of \$5.⁰⁰ per day per game machine shall become due and payable;

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption, signature by the president of the board of trustees attested to by the clerk-treasurer and published in a newspaper of general circulation within Decatur County, Indiana.
