

TOWN OF WESTPORT, INDIANA

ORDINANCE 1987- 3

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 8-15-3-9 authorizes a municipal legislative body to submit to voters the question of withdrawal of a municipally owned utility from the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Town of Westport, as the municipal legislative body, has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Town to withdraw the municipally owned water company from the jurisdiction of the public service commission;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT, STATE OF INDIANA;

SECTION 1. The following question shall be submitted to the registered voters of the Town of Westport at the next election:

Shall the Municipally owned utility be taken out of the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission for approval of rates and charges and of the issuance of stocks, bonds, notes, or other evidence of indebtedness?

SECTION 2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to submit this public question to the Decatur County Election Board pursuant to I.C. 3-10-9-2 so that it may be placed upon the ballot for the next election. In the event that it is not possible to include this question on the municipal election ballot in November, 1987, the Town Clerk shall submit this public question to the Election Board to be placed upon the ballot in the primary election in May, 1988.
