ORDINANCE 1990-5 NO LOITERING ON TOWN/PUBLIC PROPERTY

Section 1: No LOITERING or CONGREGATING to be permitted on any property of the Town of Westport, to include sidewalks, parking lots and etc., unless approved by the Westport Town Council.

Period this ordinance is in-effect from 10:30 PM to Sunrise daily.

Also, any business posting a "No Loitering" sign at the area no loitering is desired, will be enforced during the hours prescribed on the sign.

Section 2: No person or persons shall loiter or congregate upon any property controlled by the Town of Westport within the time period listed in "Section 1" above except:

(A) Where approval of the Town Council has been granted.

(B) Or any business that does not have a sign posted.

Section 3: Definition of Loitering: to idle aimlessly or hang around in an area for no obvious reason.

Definition of Congregating: more than one persons loitering in area for no obvious reason.

Section 4: Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a class C infraction.

Adopted this 8 day of October, 1990 by the Town Council, Town of Westport in public session at the Town Hall Building, Westport, Indiana.
