## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MARSHALS

WHEREAS, the town council has determined that the public safety may be served by the use in the Town of Westport of one or more deputy marshals:

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-5-7-6 authorizes but does not require the town council to delegate authority for appointing deputy marshals to the town marshal;

WHEREAS, the town council as the governing body of the town should have final authority in hiring and supervising all town employees;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Westport, Indiana:

Section 1. Ordinance 1985-4 which authorized the town marshal to appoint a deputy and reserve deputy marshals is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The town council shall select and appoint deputy marshals and reserve deputies. The council shall from time to time fix the amount of bond, compensation, and term of service of deputy and reserve marshals.
