ORDINANCE NO. 1998-4

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING LEGISLATIVE
DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF
THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WESTPORT

WHEREAS, Ind. Code 36-5-2-4.1(h) authorizes a town council to abolish legislative districts for the election of council members;

WHEREAS, in order to attract the greatest number of qualified candidates, it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Westport to elect council members at large;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the town council of Westport, Indiana that town council legislative districts are abolished, and all members of the town council shall be elected at large.

The town clerk-treasurer shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Clerk of the Decatur Circuit Court.
