TOWN OF WESTPORT ORDINANCE NO. 2003-2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONTROL OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WESTPORT

IT IS ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Westport, Indiana as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> No person who owns, keeps, or harbors a dog or domestic animal shall permit such animal to run at large within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Westport without a leash or other physical restraint.

<u>Section 2.</u> Any person who violates this Ordinance commits a Class C infraction.

Section 3. The town marshal is authorized to capture any stray animal and impound it. An animal may be reclaimed by its owner upon exhibition of evidence that any annual tax or registration fee required by law has been paid, and upon payment of a fee of $\frac{5}{10.00}$. The marshal may transport to the Decatur County Animal Shelter any animal which is not claimed within 24 hours.
