## ordinance no. 2005-4

## AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING SEWER RATES AND CHARGES RELATED TO SWIMMING POOLS

WHEREAS, the Town of Westport has in operation a sewage works for the collection and disposal of sewage in a sanitary manner;

WHEREAS, the town council is authorized under Indiana Code 36-9-23-25 to establish just and equitable fees for the services rendered by the sewage works;

WHEREAS, the town council has determined that it is just and equitable to provide for adjustments to sewer charges if large quantities of water are used by a sewer customer but will not enter the sewer system;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of Westport, Indiana:

Section 1. Customers of the Westport Water and Sewer Utility may obtain one adjustment each calendar year to their sewer use charges if a high volume of water has been used to fill a swimming pool at the customer's place of residence. Multiple adjustments will not be allowed.

Section 2. In order to obtain a sewer charge adjustment, a customer must provide the water and sewer utility office with written evidence of the size of the pool and the approximate volume of water required to fill it.

The amount of an adjustment to a customer's Section 3. Sewer charges will be based upon the volume of water used to fill the pool as determined by the water and sewer office. Any adjustment will be allowed as a credit to the next month's sewer bill.

This Oridiance is retroactive back to March 1, 2005.
