j) <u>Customer Deposits</u>

A deposit of \$100.00 is required for water service for renters and homes purchased on contract. The deposit will be returned to those purchasing on contract after three years service. The deposit will be either returned or applied to outstanding bills for all renters upon termination of service.

e) <u>Tapping Fees</u>

Each user, in advance of the time he is connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the costs of tapping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box and installing meter.

The charge for a 5/8 or 3/4 inch meter tap shall be \$400.00. The charge for a tap larger than the 3/4 inch meter tap will be the cost of labor, equipment and materials, but not less than \$400.00.

f) <u>Temporary Users</u>

Water furnished to temporary users such as contractors, etc., shall be charged on the basis of the metered gallon rates hereinbefore set forth as estimated and established by the Waterworks Superintendent.

g) <u>Turn On Fee</u>

After any water service is discontinued to any property serviced by the water utility for any reason, whether at the request of the consumer or because of failure to pay sewer or water bills, there shall be imposed a fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for turning on the water service.

h) <u>Collection and Deferred Payment Charges</u>

All bills for water services not paid within twenty (20) days from the due date thereof, as stated on such bills, shall be subject to the collection or deferred payment charge of 10% on the first \$3.00 and 3% on the excess over \$3.00.

i) Bad Check Charge

A fee of \$30.00 shall be charged for any check returned for insufficient funds.
