

Town Council Meeting
July 26th, 2024
Westport Town Hall

The Westport Town Council met in a special session at the Westport Town Hall, with the following present, Bryan Gatewood, Glenn Black, Russell Wilson, Jennifer Hryb, Dolores Honeycutt, and Clerk Treasurer, Gloria Alumbaugh. Bryan Gatewood called the meeting to order at 3 pm.

2024 Community Crossing Bid Acceptance:

Bryan presented the Community Crossing Matching Grant Bids received for the 2024-1 Paving Project. All Star Paving, Inc. submitted the lowest bid of \$554,650.25, which Glenn motioned to accept, seconded by Russell. Vote 5:0

Jennifer motioned approval for Bryan to sign the INDOT Notification of Contractor Award & Request for CCMG Funds document, seconded by Dolores. Vote 5:0

Jennifer motioned approval for Bryan to sign the CCMG Contract Agreement, seconded by Russell. Vote 5:0

Glenn approved Bryan signing the Notice of Award, seconded by Russell. Vote 5:0

Russell motioned approval for Bryan to sign Form 96, seconded by Jennifer. Vote 5:0

Bryan made a motion to permit the Council President to sign any future documents needed to complete the CCMG 2024-1 Paving Project, seconded by Dolores. Vote 5:0

FPBMH Engineer, Josh, stated that he will send an e-mail to Gloria on Monday or Tuesday of next week and she will need to forward the signed documents to INDOT, Pamela Rees.

All Star Paving, Inc. representative stated that the project will likely start after August 2024.

Animal Control Issues:

Deputy Marshal, Luke Lozier, discussed Animal Control Issues with the council due to the lack of enforcement and assistance from the county animal control officer, Mindy Myers. The council brainstormed options and Dolores and Jennifer will attend a county animal control board meeting to gain more information.

MISC.


Bryan asked for clarification on the status of the clean-up at 307 N West St. since the resident had reached out to him by telephone.
